### Cultural Events Grant

The Bay Roberts Cultural Foundation is a not-for-profit, registered charitable organization. The primary objectives of Foundation is (1) to preserve and sustain the traditions and practices of outport life for present and future generations and (2) to partner with individuals, companies, institutions, societies or associations having objects altogether or in part similar to those of the Foundation. In an attempt to meet those goals, ONE, annual Cultural Events Grant of up to \$500.00 has been established.

The attached application form is designed for individuals and groups who would like to submit a proposal for the development, organization and presentation of an event(s) that fall within the parameters of the organization's goals and objectives. It is important to note that the successful applicant(s) must demonstrate its intention to expand the awareness and understanding of the cultural heritage of our community, region, and province.

Some suggested types of events are:

- School programs such as the development and implementation of cultural education curriculum components, talks/presentations, and contests.
- Development of audio/video recordings of traditional cultural skills such as net making, dance, culinary, knitting, rug/mat making, quilting.
- Development of a creative dramatic reproduction of some local historical event
- Community event celebrating the cultural heritage of our community and area
- Workshops involving the teaching of traditional cultural skills such as net making, dance, culinary, knitting, rug/mat making, quilting.
- Research of our community's cultural heritage including audio/video recordings of the research material.
- Storytelling, musical, culinary, theatrical and/or comedic performances

Work related to funded projects should be completed within one year of the grant's approval. However, an extension of this deadline will be considered by the Board of Directors. Applicants may submit another application in the year following the awarding of the initial grant.
